Taking into account the course of tributes to the Centenary of the Patron of Brazilian Education, which will close this cycle of activities in Brazil and in the world in 2022, and, above all, because of the epistemological and philosophical relevance of the Brazilian intellectual, the editorial body of this journal begins to receive scientific articles resulting from studies, research reports and educational experiences that analyse both the theoretical contribution of the educator and the phenomena of the educational reality in the light of Freire's contributions. In addition to the scientific findings, with this proposal we make explicit our conviction that to read and reread Paulo Freire, from different perspectives, is to maintain hope in the possibility of realising a critical, liberating and, therefore, truly just. and emancipatory education.
